1873

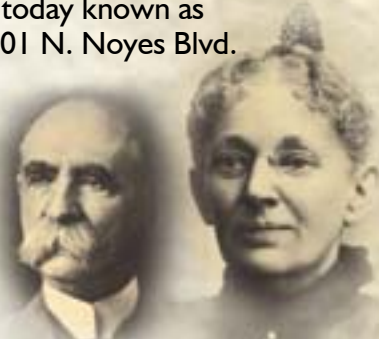
Ladies Union Benevolent Association (LUBA) forms



1894

Charles and Sarepta build Home for Little Wanderers, today known as Noyes Home at 801 N. Noyes Blvd.

LUBA agrees to manage the Noyes Home.



Charles Noyes passes away and makes provision for the Noyes Home to receive continual support



1912

Howard Engleman, former resident, passes away at 15 years of age and leaves request that his possessions be sold and money sent to Noyes Home. A chime clock is purchased with his gift.



1913

Dr. Harold E. Petersen is the attending physician for the Noyes Home from 1934 until his retirement in 1975. He is affectionately referred to as "Dr. Pete."
